### **You have the right to:**

- Specify the fund or project your donation will benefit.
- Expect your gift will be used in the way you intended.
- Know RCF complies with federal, state, and municipal laws.
- A timely and courteous acknowledgement of your gift.
- Access to staff by phone or in person to answer your inquiries.
- Obtain a copy of the organization's most recent audited financial statements
- Obtain a list of governing board members providing oversight to the organization's mission.
- Know that all information provided by the Foundation is truthful and accurate.
